- 69 **Dolcetto d'Asti – DOC Giardino dei Vini, Italy** £14.00 £4.00
Dolcetto is an early ripening grape, low in acid, producing a soft, fruity wine. This wine is a firmer more tannic style of Dolcetto, with glorious, rich, plummy fruit on the palate.
- 70 **1993 Cabernet Sauvignon Envejecido en Bodega – Chile** £19.00
This oldest vintage of Chilean wine available in the UK. Concentrated and well structured, good tannins, round, of great character and a long finish.
- 71 **Haut Medoc - Chateau Lamothe Cissac 2003** £24.00
A strong vintage harvest has given this wine majestic fruit and a softened backbone of tannin, lovely Claret.
- 72 **Reserva Rioja 1995 - Jaun de Alzate, Spain** £28.00
Jaun de Alzate is produced from grapes which are selected for their outstanding quality. The wine spends just over two years in oak and at least three in bottle.
- 72 **Savigny, Les Beaune - Pierre Janny, Burgundy** £33.00
A mellow and well rounded style of Savigny. The tannins are present but fine and well defined, they underline rather than mask the aromas of cherry, kirsch and vanilla.
- 74 **Gran Reserva Rioja 1994 - Jaun de Alzate, Spain** £35.00
Jaun de Alzate Gran Reserva reflects superb quality. It has spent up to two and a half years in oak and four years minimum in a bottle, ageing in the cellar. It has a refined bouquet of ripe and velvety soft finish.
- 75 **2002 Pauillac - Chateau Lynch Moussas 5eme Cru, Bordeaux** £45.00
A blend of 65% Cabernet and 30% Merlot, this wine has a dark rubycolor, ripe nose, with dark cherry scents and a light minty quality. Ripon the palate, with just a hint of prune and raisin.

- 76 **Semillon Riesling - Santa Monica, Chile 50cl** £15.00 £3.75
A beautiful light golden hue with peach and pear aromas, intermingled with luscious tones of honey and vanilla.
- 77 **Loupiac – Chateau Segur de Cros, France** £23.00
A yellow gold, sweet and honeyed dessert wine made from late picked Semillon grapes blended with a small amount of sauvignon Blanc and Muscadelle.

- 78 **Vougeot Premier Cru 1996 – Clos Blanc de Vougeot** £65.00
A bit of a rarity from the Cotes de Nuit which is famous for its fabulous reds. A wine of great class and elegance – layer upon layer of luscious fruit, perfectly balanced with creamy oak.
- 79 **Chateau Gruaud Larose 1995 – 2eme Cru, Saint Julien** £80.00
Gruaud Larose is a large property that consistently produces great wines. Full bodied, rich and plummy with masses of fruit. Its concentrated, spicy blackcurrant flavour is well supported by a powerful structure of ripe tannins.
- 80 **Corton Charlemagne 2003 – Comte Senard, Burgundy** £95.00
A wine famed for it's full blast of rich, buttery, nutty, vanilla flavours, a wine of the ultimate Grand Cru status from Labouré Roi.
- 81 **Chateau Lascombes 1990 – 2eme Cru Margaux** £110.00
A good vintage. This wine now at maturity with nice sweet ripe fruit, soft tannins is drinking very well.
- 82 **Chateau Figeac 1997 – Grand Cru Saint Emilion** £125.00
Fragrant on the nose, full and approachable on the palate. Like many 1997's forward in development.
- 83 **1997 Chateau L'Angelis – Grand Cru Classe, St Emillion** £150.00
This is purple/black in colour with a huge, smoky nose of tobacco, chocolate, herbs and liquorice. There is a roasted richness to the wine as well as full body.

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- 1 **Mumm Brut NV** £33.50 £5.50
A dry style with delicate fruit and a spritzzy crisp finish
- 2 **Perrier Jouet Brut NV** £35.00 £6.50
Sweet strawberries and a hint of rose petal. Sumptuous!
- 3 **Mumm Rosè NV** £40.00 £7.50
An attractive salmon pink colour with a red fruit and creamy strawberry nose.
- 4 **Veuve Clicquot Brut NV** £45.00
Aromas of toasty vanilla & hazelnut. An exquisitely rich champagne with a lovely fresh finish – pure elegance.
- 5 **Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque Vintage 1996** £95.00
Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque 1996 is a world class wine, famed for its elegance, complexity, and finesse. Delightful crisp acidity with fresh citrus fruit and complex hints of subtle spices.
- 6 **1995 Dom Perignon** £100.00
The king of champagne' not just a flashy name, exceptional depth and rich texture with nuances of dried apricot and toasted brioche and a long honeyed finish.

Clean and fresh, with fine, ripe tropical fruit aromas and a lovely finish.
- 9 **Chardonnay – Le Pavillon, France** £12.00 £3.25
Golden hues and swatches of peach and pineapple fruits finishing with refreshing lemon acidity.
- 10 **Sauvignon Blanc – Le Pavillon, France** £12.00 £3.25
An excellent example of a tropical style Sauvignon Blanc – not a green gooseberry in site!
- 11 **Chenin Blanc – Mount Marble, South Africa** £12.00 £3.25
Good balance of fruit and acidity on the palate, followed by a fresh, zesty finish.

- 12 **Chenin Chardonnay – Finca Beltran Duo, Argentina** £13.00 £3.50
Lively tropical fruits dominate the senses, finishing with deliciously creamy and slightly honeyed peach and pear flavour.
- 13 **Piemonte Cortese – DOC Giardino dei Vini, Italy** £13.00 £3.50
This wine has a great citrus and elderflower character, with a rounded body followed by zesty acidity.
- 14 **Riesling – Santa Monica, Chile** £14.00 £3.75
A lovely dry style of Riesling with intense citric and floral notes with a minerally fresh acidity.
- 15 **Sauvignon Blanc - Santa Monica, Chile** £14.00 £3.75
Rich fragrances of apple, pear, citrus, with charming floral overtones and accents of honey.
- 16 **Pinot Grigio - Giardino dei Vini, Italy** £16.00 £4.50
Ripe, grapey fruit and a clean, fresh finish.
- 17 **Sauvignon Blanc – Chateau du Cros, Bordeaux** £16.00
A lovely crisp, dry and characterful Sauvignon with floral aromas.
- 18 **Chablis – Eugene Lebreton, Burgundy** £23.00
Lovely depth of flavour, dry yet lingering on the palate with a satisfying long finish.
- 19 **Sauvignon/Semillon – Augusta Estate, Australia** £25.00
This wine is clean and fresh, displaying loads of fruit.

- 20 **Chardonnay – El Otro, Chile** £12.00 £3.25
Clean and fresh, with fine, ripe tropicalfruit aromas.
- 21 **Chardonnay – Gumdale Australia** £14.00
Full of ripe tropical fruit with undertones of soft creamy oak.
- 22 **Macon Blanc Villages – Cave de Lugny, Burgundy** £18.00
This Macon Villages is very elegant, has plenty of fruit character and zesty acidity - classic white Burgundy.
- 23 **Sancerre 2004 – Earl Doucet, Loire, France** £27.00
Dry, elegant full of gooseberry character, showing a full ripe flavour with excellent balance.

TRADITIONAL FULL BODIED WHITES

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- 24 **Bourgogne Aligote – Thomas Bassot, Burgundy,** £18.00 £4.75
Clean and fresh, with full fruity flavour and bouquet.
- 25 **Pouilly Fuisse Pierre Janny, Loire** £28.00
A well structured, well balanced white burgundy showing a honeydew, buttery palate with a medium to long finish.
- 26 **Chablis Premier Cru Beauregard 2003, Val de Mercy** £29.00
Lovely depth of flavour, dry yet lingering on the palate with a satisfying long finish.
- 27 **Chablis Premier Cru 2000 – Vaillons, Burgundy** £35.00
A Chablis of distinction .Fine and delicate with good colour
- 28 **Meursault 1ere Cru 1999 – Genevrieres, Dom. Bocard** £65.00
This wine is nutty, buttery and spicy with overtones of honey, cinnamon and vanilla. Deliciously dry and rich.

- 29 **Chenin Semillon Chardonnay – Oddsocks, Australia** £12.00 £3.25
A great combination of three un-oaked grape varieties producing limy citrusy flavours with a dry finish.
- 30 **Sauvignon Blanc –Surazo, Chile** £13.00 £3.50
Fresh, zesty and extremely popular.
- 31 **White Rioja – Gomez de Segura, Spain** £14.00 £3.75
Silky smooth, with floral bouquet, it is crisp, dry and distinctive
- 32 **Gavi DOC – La Slina, Italy** £18.00 £4.75
Green apple notes on the palate. A well made, crisp and clean wine.
- 33 **Sauvignon Blanc - Overstone, NZ** £23.00 £5.95
A crisp, light, classic expression of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with concentrated flavours of gooseberry, citrus and melon.
- 34 **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2003, New Zealand** £35.00
The wine exhibits pronounced gooseberry and herbal notes with sweet stone fruit flavours.
- 35 **Meursault - Limozin, Domaine Bocard, Burgundy** £55.00
Full, fatty and buttery balance with good acidity, producing a fine white Burgundy at a good price.

ROSE WINES

- 36 **Rioja Rosé – Gomez de Segura, Spain** £14.00 £3.75
A dry, crisp and lively wine with delicious flavours of raspberries and strawberries.
- 37 **Pinot Grigio Blush – Fabiano, Italy** £15.00 £4.25
A pretty salmon coloured rose wine which is dry but very fruity and exceedingly well balanced.
- 38 **Syrah Rosé – Finca Beltran** £17.00 £4.50
Crisp, dry, medium-bodied, and just crying for a warm summer evening!
- 39 **Sancerre Rosé - Guy Saget, Loire** £30.00
Lovely soft fruit flavours with amazing depth and finish.

- 40 **Tempranillo –Castillo de la Vereda Spain,** £11.00 £3.00
Bursting with red fruit flavours.
- 41 **Shiraz Cabernet Merlot – Oddsocks, Australia** £12.00 £3.25
The palate showsintense plum flavours, with soft balanced tannins and a well rounded finish.
- 42 **Merlot – Surazo, Chile** £12.00 £3.25
This Chilean Merlot is full of cherry and plum flavours with soft ripe tannins and a long fruity finish.
- 43 **Merlot – Baron d’Harcourt, France** £12.00 £3.25
Ripe fruit and the loveliest velvety finish.
- 44 **Cabernet Sauvignon – Le Pavillon, France** £12.0 £3.25
Smooth with sweet and gentle tannins.

Lovely rich Blackcurrant palate, full depth of smooth fruits make this wine a knock out.
- 48 **Bourgogne Pinot Noir- Thomas Bassot, France** £19.00
From the highly respected Maison Thomas Bassot, this is a ripe, vibrant and appealing wine from the 'holy grail' of grape varieties.
- 49 **Brouilly ‘Montoux’ 2004 - Pierre Janny, Burgundy** £20.00
A deep ruby-coloured, young and fresh Brouilly with vibrant flavour.
- 50 **Pinot Noir – Overstone, NZ** £25.00
A stunning New World Pinot with excellent fruit concentration offering cherry and red berry flavours with layers of spice.

DRY SPICY, FRUITY REDS

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- 51 **Tempranillo Malbec – Finca Beltran Duo, Argentina** £13.00 £3.50
Light bodied, bursting with cherries, red fruits and a hint of spice. Boundless fruit at a great price.
- 52 **Rioja Crianza - Montes de Ciria, Spain** £16.00 £4.50
Slightly oaky but still vigorous with ripe fruit and subtle tannins and a long finish.
- 53 **Rioja Reserva 2000 - Montes de Ciria, Spain** £20.00
This velvety Rioja has oak flavours from cask maturation. Finished with smooth aromatic characters.
- 54 **Amarone Classico Riserva Di Remo Farina 1999, Italy** £33.00
Warm, generous, easy drinking red wine, light in style proving that a single grower can really excel.
- 55 **Margaux, Chateau Jacques Boyd, 2000, Bordeaux** £40.00
Very traditional and typically Margaux palate – fine bouquet, elegant, racy wine with a predominant impression of harmony.

RICH & FLAVOURSOME REDS

- 56 **Syrah - Pavillon, France** £12.00 £3.25
Lots of fruit and a lovely long velvety finish.
- 57 **Cabernet Sauvignon– Baron d’Harcourt, France** £12.00 £3.25
Well structured with very ripe fruit and a great finish.
- 58 **Shiraz – Mount Marble, South Africa** £13.00 £3.50
Fine soft tannins support the dense fruit flavours.
- 59 **Merlot - Santa Monica, Chile** £14.00 £3.75
Intense red fruit and floral nose, with overtones of cassis, morello cherry, plum and strawberry.
- 60 **Cabernet Sauvignon – Gumdale, Australia** £14.00
A medium/full-bodied wine, with deep colour and nose of ripened Blackcurrants.
- 61 **Pinotage 2004 - Bergsig Estate, South Africa** £19.00
This wine shows power in assertive fruits and strength in body.
- 62 **Cabernet Sauvignon 2000 – Augusta Estate, Australia** £25.00
Ruby colour and black cherry aromas with hints of earthiness and spice.

- 63 **Bordeaux Château Les Maurins** £15.00 £4.00
Some of the finest Cabernet fruit supported by soft tannins
- 64 **Saint Emilion 2003 - Château Franc Le Maine** £23.00
This early maturing vintage is soft and approachable.
- 65 **La Licorne - AC Medoc** £23.00
This is an elegant claret; deep ruby in colour, with herbs and cassis on the nose, and a luscious full flavour.
- 66 **Shiraz 2000 – Augusta Estate, Australia** £24.00
A delicious, fruity and full-bodied wine.
